Today in Farm History - John Froelich born 1849

On November 24, 1849, John Froelich was born in Giard, Iowa. In 1892 he built the first gasoline tractor that could drive both forward and reverse and pull a thresher, then used it for the South Dakota harvest. His Waterloo Gasoline Engine Company became Waterloo Boy, which John Deere bought in 1918 for \$2.35 million. Source: Iowa State Historical Society; Smithsonian National Museum of American History.
